

Editorial

"Adapting to better promote children's rights"

Supported by core values, organisations operate within stable statutory frameworks, but they also have to change to strengthen their effectiveness and better fulfil their missions.

OMEP-France evolved this year in order to:

- Organise cooperation with academics and researchers: the new scientific commission has conducted a survey of early childhood experts, participated in the work of OMEP's Frenchspeaking commission and proposed one of its members as co-editor of the International Journal of Early Childhood, published by OMEP-World.
- Prepare, with the training commission, the implementation of actions aimed at early childhood stakeholders to work more closely with local professionals and institutions.
- Promote educational activities in preschools and early childhood centres by publishing short activity guides for specific international days (children's rights, mother tongues, play), by promoting the OMEP-World 'Colour your rights' competition and by producing videos, particularly on sustainable development.

Strengthen communication:

- Towards the public, by redesigning the website, increasing his presence on social media and giving the OMEP-France newsletter (quarterly since 2018) a new layout.
- For members, by digitising institutional life, which has strengthened internal democracy, with special access areas, anonymous voting and a greater number of meetings.
- Towards French officials. Meetings with advisers to the Prime Minister and ministries responsible for ECCE have raised awareness of OMEP, which is now associated with working groups.

OMEP-France also had the privilege to sustain the implementation of the Francophone Commission. Actions organised by the Francophone committees on three continents enabled knowledge sharing and analysis on fundamental issues to ECCE (ESD, linguistic diversity, quality/inclusion) and strengthened relations with UNESCO to support local action. A logo and a dedicated microsite on OMEP-World website gave visibility to this brand new OMEP commission.

Finally, OMEP-France provides support to OMEP representatives to UNESCO. The commitment of the president, relayed by local representatives, facilitated the implementation of new actions involving OMEP (Technical Advisory Group on Tashkent, webinars in French and English). Enhanced communication has given greater visibility to this partnership on social media.

These developments, made possible by the involvement of all, were supported by competent interns recruited through a partnership with associations.

The French committee thus seeks to contribute to the national and international influence of OMEP, to better inform and respond to the needs of local actors, who must be listened to carefully in order to act more effectively.
